



The Antarctic sea comprises those portions of the adjacent oceans extending within the Antarctic circle. The tracks of the different navigators represented on this map show how far the Polar regions have been penetrated by vessels.

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The Antarctic Continent extends from 96° to 160° E. Long. It was discovered and explored by the U.S. Expedition, Comd. Wilkes, Commander, Jan. 12th to Feb. 21st 1840. The greatest portion of coast visible at one time was computed to be about 75 miles in length and elevated at one point 3000 feet.

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
