burgh in English measured Miles.



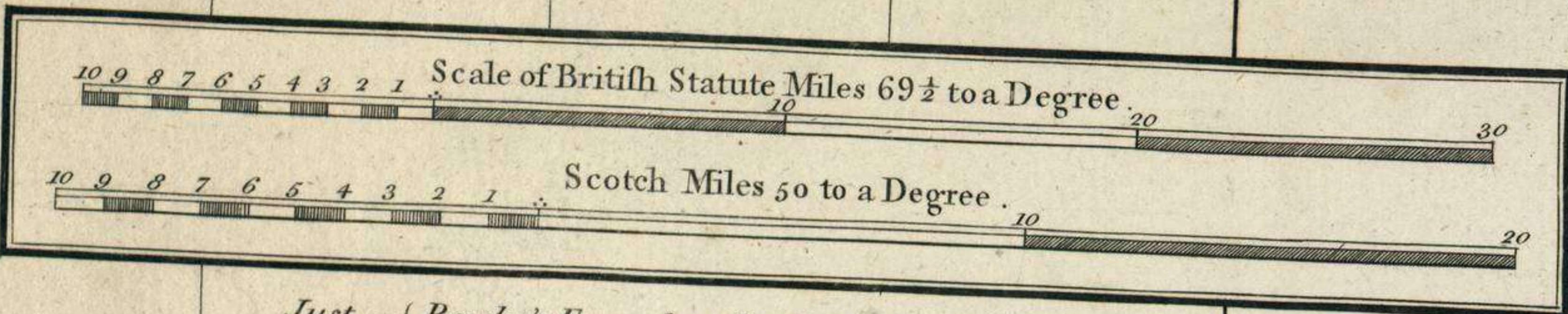
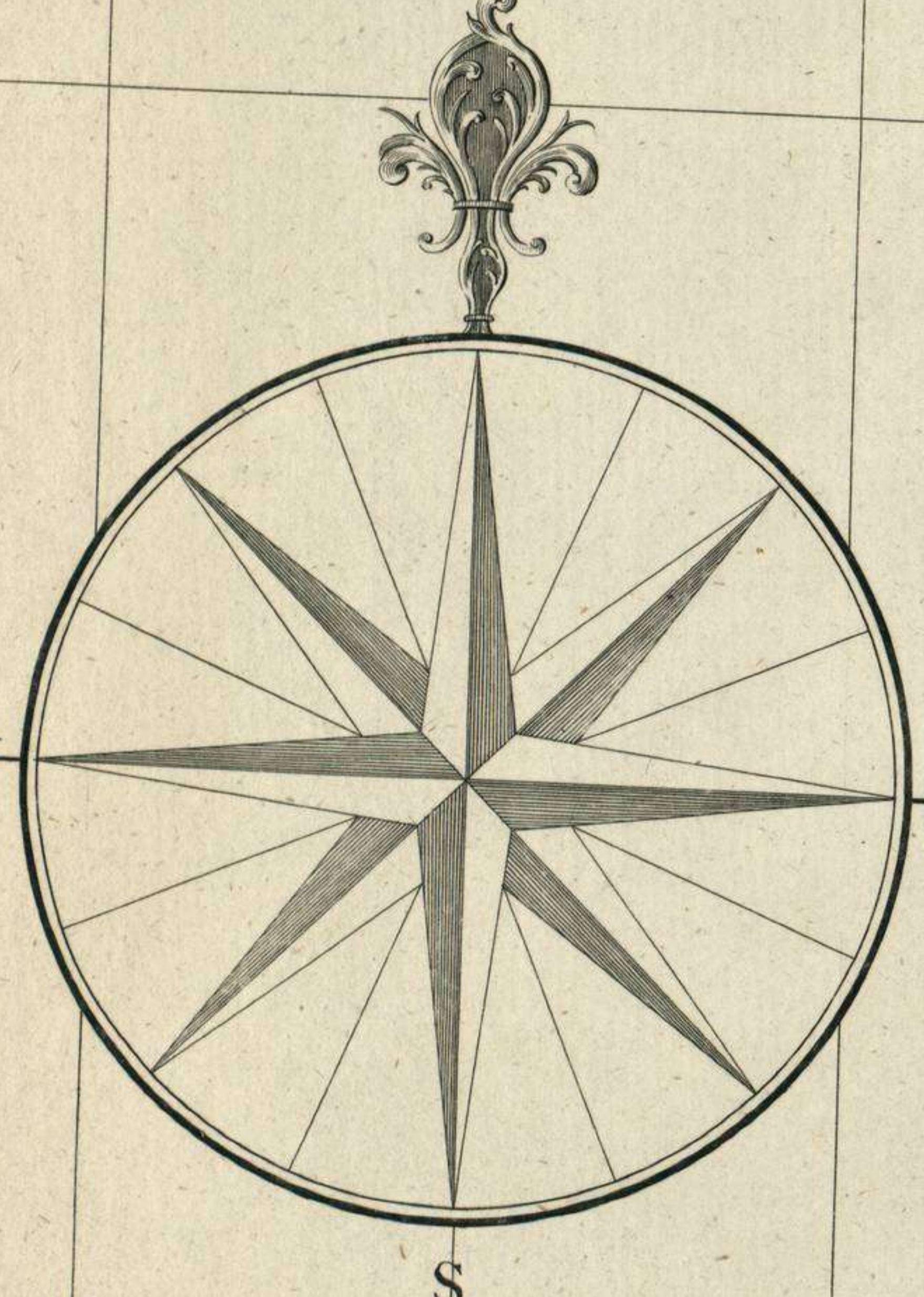


N.B. The Orkney and Shetland Isles constitute the Shire of Orkney.
